A STEP-BY STEP GUIDE TO USING ZOOM VIDEO CONFERENCING TECHNOLOGY

- Zoom is a safe and free computer program that BCNA uses to keep our community connected and hold online virtual meetings, and is accessible even without a computer!
- You can listen in using a landline telephone or use your cell phone; tablet or a computer with a microphone to interact live.

STEPS TO ACCESS ZOOM



STEP 1: BEFORE A VIDEO CONFERENCE

1. You will need to register with the BCNA by e-mailing us at mycommunity@bayviewcummer.ca

STEP 2: TO JOIN THE VIDEO CONFERENCE BY COMPUTER OR PHONE

1. You will receive a “zoom invitation” a “link” by-email to join via computer or by telephone number so you can call in by telephone at the designated time. Both will include a 9-digit meeting ID and password.
2. If you are joining by cell phone or tablet you will need to download the Zoom app first, and follow the previous step before clicking the link.
3. At the start time of the meeting, click the link on your invitation to join the computer or call in via telephone and enter the meeting ID or password when requested.
4. Zoom will give you a chance to “Test Computer Audio”, once you are confident it works you can click “Join audio by computer”.
