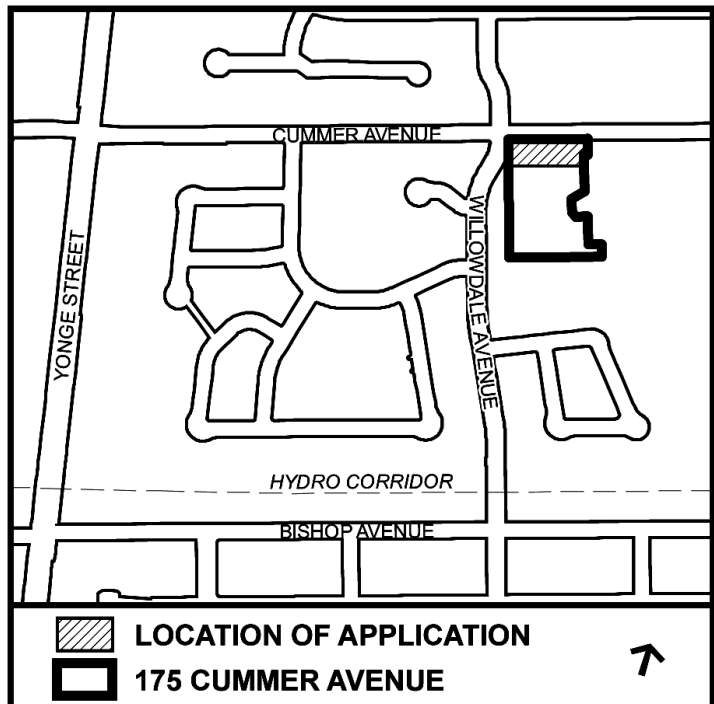

#### Background and Proposal

On March 9, 2022, City Council directed City staff to undertake a municipal rezoning process to permit the development of a three-storey apartment building at 175 Cummer Avenue, and to report back to Planning and Housing Committee on April 27, 2022. As proposed, the apartment building is intended to provide up to 60 dwelling units for people experiencing homelessness, along with offices for support staff, a communal kitchen, a dining room and a lounge, as well as laundry facilities. Indoor and outdoor communal amenity space is proposed to be provided.

- History of the project, including previous community consultations undertaken; and
